

Priority #6:

An environment that supports aligning facilities with educational needs.

Goal A:

JCC will have security upgrades in all buildings.

1. The number of entrances to each building will be limited.
2. We will create procedures for all visitors entering each building.
3. We will update the security trainings for all staff.
4. The district emergency procedures manual will be reviewed and updated each summer.
5. All updated emergency procedures will be posted in all rooms of each building.

Goal B:

JCC will have Comprehensive Behavior Plan relevant to each building that meets our students' educational needs.

1. Both Elementary Schools will implement Husky Pride student behavior plan by the end of 2015-16.
2. Middle School will implement its Husky Pride plan by end of 2016-17.
3. High School will implement its version of a Husky Pride plan by end of 2017-18.
4. All comprehensive behavior plans will be presented to the JCC School Board for annual approval in each school's handbook in June.

Goal C:

We will effectively maintain the school district's (10-Year) Long-Term Facilities Management Plan.

1. The Facilities Committee will put together the initial Long-Term Facilities Plan in August 2015 by prioritizing the repair and replacement schedule of district properties.
2. Thereafter, each summer the Facilities Committee will update the district's Long-Term Facilities Management Plan and present to the School Board each August.
3. The School Board will levy the Long-Term Facilities Management Fund to the following levels in each of the coming years:
 - a. \$125,000 in 2015-16.
 - b. \$256,000 in 2016-17.
 - c. \$385,000 in 2017-18.
 - d. \$500,000 in 2018-19 and each year thereafter.
4. The School Board will continue to monitor facility and spacing needs for all of our educational programs in all of our school buildings.
